1. FEES:

Payment Options:

- Payment in full at registration (check or cash).
- Installments (Installment Agreement required) - \$250 down payment required.

Other Financial Policy Requirements:

Note – Per Club Finance Policy, full payment of fees OR an installment agreement signed at the time of registration is required before a player's NISL or IWSL player card will be processed. Failure to make installment payments will result in player's ineligibility for training or games. In addition, all past due balances must be paid in full before a player will be allowed to register for the 2010 – 2011 season.

Discounts:

- \$50 discount for each additional child from one family.

Scholarships:

- Scholarships are available based on financial need. Please complete scholarship application.

2. REQUIRED REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS AND OTHER ITEMS:

Please be prepared to provide or sign the following at registration: (Club forms and documents will be available on the Club website and at registration).

- Birth Certificate (new players only - not required for returning players)
- Payment (payment in full or \$250.00 down payment)
- Fee Agreement (for fees paid in installments)
- Agreement for Automated Clearinghouse Payments (for fees paid in installments)
- IYSA Medical Release and/or US Clubs Medical Release
- Player/Parent Commitment Letter
- Code of Conduct (players and parents)
- Volunteer Policy
- Financial Policy
- Player photo (to be taken at registration)

3. GENERAL CLUB INFORMATION:

The success of the Rock Run Soccer Club depends on volunteers. Parents will be required to volunteer their time at Club related activities and events including working at the club hosted tournaments and participating in fund raising activities. (See Volunteer Policy)

4. REGISTRATION DATE AND LOCATION:

- After the completion of try-outs, players selected to play for the Rock Run Soccer Club will be contacted by a Rock Run coach. A list of the selected players will also be posted on our web site at www.rockrun.org.
- Registration dates and location will be announced at try-outs and will be posted on the Rock Run web site.

5. WHO MUST ATTEND REGISTRATION:

Players. Players must be present so that their pictures can be taken for their player passes, and so that they can sign a roster form, the player commitment form and player conduct form.

Parents/Guardians. Both parents or guardians should attend registration if at all possible; but at least one parent or guardian must attend so that the Club can obtain signatures on required documents, such as the fee installment agreement and the parent code of conduct.
